
 Location of Nauru Post


Venue, Date & Dress Code

- Venue: Civic Center Conference Room, Aiwo, Nauru
- Date: To be advised in November 2022 after the UPU determines the dates for the 2023 Extraordinary Congress and CA and POC 2023.4 sessions
- The dress code for the meeting and all functions is "Island Style" (no ties), unless indicated otherwise.



Airline – Nauru Airlines

- Flights to and from Nauru occur several times per week
- Flights will be scheduled from Brisbane, Australia and Fiji to meet the needs of all participants for this meeting.
- Brisbane-Nauru-Brisbane
 - Economy Y Class: \$3818.00(incl of taxes)
 - Business J Class: \$4080.00(incl of taxes)
- Nadi(Fiji)-Nauru-Nadi(Fiji)
 - Economy Y Class: \$2519.00(incl of taxes)
 - Business J Class: \$2871.00(incl of taxes)
- Economy Booking: Fully flexible / No rebooking fees / Refundable ticket / 30kgs Baggage allowance.
- Business Class Booking : Fully flexible / No rebooking fees / Refundable ticket / 45kgs Baggage allowance.



Medical And Insurance

Visa Requirements

- All participants will require a visa.
- Working with the APPU Bureau, Nauru will arrange visa authority letters for all participants in advance of the meeting.
- Participant lists accompanied by copies of the passport data page for each participant will enable the visas to be issued.
- Visa fees for All APPU EC attendees will be waived


General Information



Local Transportation : Participants will travel by bus between the hotel and conference center. Should participants wish to use their own transport, car rentals are available, or alternatively, they may choose to walk.



Excursion : An excursion for all delegates will be arranged by Nauru Post. Those who wish to attend the excursion are requested to show their prior interest. Further information will be provided prior to the meeting.



Accommodation

Accommodation will be arranged at the Menen Hotel which is a 5-minute drive from the venue of the conference. The current rates of the rooms are as follows:

- Standard Room: \$185 per night
- Ocean View Loft : \$200 per night

Internet Access

- Free WIFI access will be available during the meeting at the meeting venue.
- Internet at hotel will have to be paid by the delegates.

Note – The host and local secretariat will not bear the cost of insurance, medical expenses, or any other personal expenses of the delegates/participants. The host and local secretariat request the delegates/participants to make their own arrangements for insurance and medical cover before travelling to Nauru.

- Language : English
- Time Zone : UTC+12 hours
(There is no daylight saving time in Nauru.)

Electricity

- Voltage: 240V
- Australian plugs/power points are used.

Credit Cards

Major credit cards such as VISA, and Master Card are accepted by some business establishments, but not local small shops.

Climate

- Summer Temperature : 28°C to 35°C
- Occasional rains expected – recommend bringing raincoats or umbrellas
- Summer clothes are most suitable.

Banks And Currency:

- Currency : Australian Dollars
- Bank : Bendigo Bank
- ATM Facility – available at Menen Hotel, and Bendigo Bank(only AUD withdrawals)
- Payment accepted via EFTPOS or online


Communications


