REPORT OF THE APPU E-SERVICES WORKING GROUP

- 1. The meeting started at 14:05 with a brief introduction by the Chair about the objectives and goals of the APPU eServices Working Group. The main objectives are:
 - a. Promote greater cooperation in e-Commerce activities among Posts
 - b. Assist developing countries in getting eServices delivered to the market at a quicker pace
 - c. Share experiences (good or bad), best practices, and technologies on eServices and eCommerce development
- 2. The Chair proposed the formation of three subgroups within the Working Group: Products and Services Development Subgroup, Knowledge Development and Training Subgroup, and e-Commerce Subgroup.
- 3. It was also suggested that the subgroup formation to be done in November 2013. Tasks to be done by the Working Group will be discussed through a teleconference call to be held during this time. A follow-up teleconference call is scheduled for 1st quarter of 2014.
- 4. Two presentations about e-Commerce trends in the Asia Pacific region and about the upcoming new Global Customer Services System for PRIME customers were given by Ms. Kathleen Treanor from IPC.
- 5. The Chair also gave a quick overview of a new electronic delivery platform called SEPBox offered by Macao Post to all Macao citizens.
- 6. The Chair concluded the meeting by urging active cooperation of the members lest no concrete deliverables can be achieved by the end of 2014. The meeting ended at 15:15.
