Market Study in connection with the Establishment of Digital Library

- 1. The APPU Bureau conducted a market study regarding the establishment of a Digital Library in the Bureau. A core team was formed within the Bureau to assess the current library infrastructure, requirements, innovation in the market, and pricing of various products and services.
- 2. After the desk research, visits were conducted as part of the market survey. Different options deployed in the public libraries in Bangkok and the infrastructure at the Universities in Thailand was studied. Presentations were also made by various service providers.
- 3. As a result of the finalization of the requirements and the market survey, it was recommended by the core team that the requirements in this phase of the project could include:
 - (a) Web module
 - (b) Cataloging module
 - (c) Circulation module
 - (d) Membership module
 - (e) Multimedia module
 - (f) Report module
 - (g) Management module

Further, on an installation front, the project should also include:

- (a) Installation of the Library Management Software
- (b) Configuration
- (c) Customization
- (d) User Training
- (e) Annual Maintenance
- 4. Based on these inputs, different vendors were contacted, and the list of offerings from three different vendors based on the requirements of the Bureau is tabulated below:

The price listed in the table does not include essential system requirements for installing the Digital Library, such as the server, system ports, file server computer, operating software system (Microsoft Windows Standard Core 2012 or a newer version, including 5-user client access licenses), and Microsoft SQL Server Standard Edition 2012 or newer. Additional costs beyond the quoted price for these hardware and software installations could amount to approximately 150,000 Baht.

The first-year maintenance service is covered in the quotation. Subsequent maintenance services will be charged based on specific issues, maintenance needs, or system upgrades over time.

6. Based on this analysis, it is found that the establishment of necessary hardware, software, and other server and connectivity arrangements will cost around USD 14,000. Furthermore, a budget of USD 2,000 has to be earmarked for three years for the hardware as well as the software. The budget to be earmarked for the purchase of resources will be as per actuals.
