1. The Credentials Committee comprising India, Indonesia (Chair), New Zealand, Thailand met on 29 August, 31 August, and 1 September 2022.
2. In the first meeting the Chair advised the meeting that the Committee's task is to examine the credentials of the member countries in accordance with the provision of the Article 4 of the Rules of Procedure of Congresses to confirm that they have been submitted in due and proper form.
3. At the second meeting on 31 August, the Committee reached a position where all 32 sets of credentials received were assessed by the Committee as meeting the requirements of the Rules of Procedure.
4. A proxy had been received from Samoa (authorising New Zealand to vote on its behalf in the event of a secret ballot). The proxy meets the conditions required for the online / physical participation situation.
5. At the third meeting the Committee confirmed that the tally for the format of documents was 29 received in hard copy, and three in electronic form.
