Greetings from the Asian-Pacific Postal Union (APPU)!

We are pleased to share with you information regarding the upcoming capacity-building initiatives being organized by the Government of India under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) program.

ITEC is a flagship initiative of the Government of India aimed at strengthening international cooperation and capacity building through the exchange of knowledge, skills, and expertise. As part of this initiative, India offers a wide range of fully funded training and development programs tailored to the needs of partner countries.

In the postal sector, India conducts specialized training courses through the Rafi Ahmed Kidwai National Postal Academy (RAKNPA), a premier institution located in Ghaziabad, near New Delhi. In view of the high demand and success of past editions - which witnessed more than 200 applications for just three courses - India has expanded the number of ITEC training programs in the postal domain from three to six.

These fully funded courses cover a range of topics including international mail management, postal e-commerce, digital services, quality management, postal technologies, and leadership development. This form is to be submitted to the nodal Government Department/ Agency of applicant's country, who will, in turn, forward the applications to the Embassy/ High Commission of India for the respective country for further processing, approval and to arrange for the travel, visa etc. The lodging and local travel will be arranged by RAKNPA.
