- Name of the act/law/rule: Maldives Postal Services Act 2006
- Year of enactment: 2006

Coordinating body for postal policies

- Name of the coordinating body/ministry/committee/agency: Ministry of Homeland Security and Technology
- Level (Ministry or other): ministry

Regulatory authority

- Name of the coordinating regulator: Communications Authority of Maldives (CAM)
- Covered areas:
 - Licensing of any entity providing a postal service.
 - Monitoring the national postal operator's performance with respect to its fulfilment of the universal service obligation;
 - Arrangements for the opening and examination of articles, and of the contents thereof, carried by the national postal operator and private postal operators;
 - Arrangements with respect to undeliverable articles and the forfeiture and destruction of articles carried by the national postal operator and private postal operators.

- Name of the coordinating body/ministry/committee/agency: Communications Authority of Maldives
- Types of licenses required: Not yet implemented as the exiting postal law is currently under discussion with a view to updating it.
